Pump Station Upgrade (2004)**

RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 4802-306-11 be awarded to the low bidder, Trittech Industries Ltd., in the amount of \$367,010.00 including GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 4802-306-11 consists of supply and installation of an axial flow submersible propeller pump, electrical equipment and structural seismic upgrade. The work will improve conveyance and increase the area's drainage service as recommended in the Master Drainage Plan for the area.

Construction is expected to start by mid-July 2004 and be completed by December 23, 2004.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the above contract were received on June 9, 2004, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$376,000 including GST.

EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed all tenders and found no legal or mathematical errors. Trittech Industries Ltd. is the low bidder. They have performed similar work with the City of Vancouver in 2002 and 2003 involving the upgrading of a 100 hp pump station, and the work was completed in a professional and satisfactory manner.
