## RECOMMENDATION

That the construction contract for the North Surrey Recreation Centre Improvements and Expansion be awarded to Pax Construction Ltd., the low bidder, for a total amount of \$1,825,685.00 plus GST.

## **BACKGROUND**

The improvements at the North Surrey Recreation Centre are part of the Whalley Enhancement Strategy of Council. It consists of improvements to the main entrance to the facility, the addition of a weight and cardio room as well as multi-purpose rooms for programming and rentals. Construction also includes deferred maintenance items to take advantage of lower costs associated with inclusion in the overall project and is funded through the Facilities maintenance budget. Two bids were received and Pax Construction Ltd. was the lowest bid. The bids received were as follows:

Pax Construction \$1,825,685 plus GST

Dominion Fairmile Construction \$2,158,000

Double V Construction Withdrew from the process

All bids were reviewed for errors and were found to be correct. The proposed construction costs at the North Surrey Recreation Centre are within available funding.

## **CONCLUSION**

It is recommended to award the construction contract for the North Surrey Recreation Centre be awarded to the low bidder, Pax Construction Ltd., for a total amount of \$1,825,685.00 plus GST.
