RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 1705-004-11 be awarded to the low bidder, TAG Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$4,960,330.61, including GST, subject to receiving funding approval from TransLink for their 50% share.

SCOPE OF WORK

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1705-004-11 were received on March 10, 2005, with the results as follows:

2. B&B Contracting Ltd.	\$5,246,600.00
3. B. Cusano Contracting Inc.	\$5,765,606.19
4. JJM Construction Ltd.	\$6,163,200.00

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$4.9 million including GST.

EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed all tenders. No legal or mathematical errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, TAG Construction Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 150 working days as stipulated in the contract. TAG's past performance on similar work with the City has been satisfactory.

FUNDING

64 Avenue is designated as part of the Major Road Network for the region and, as such, is eligible for 50% funding from TransLink. Funding is available within the approved Engineering budget. However, funding approval from TransLink is still in process although we anticipate this approval shortly. Consequently, it is recommended that the award be made subject to the TransLink funding.
