 SUBJECT: Contract Award - M.S. 4805-001-11, Mission Contractors Ltd.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 4805-001-11 be awarded to the low bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., in the amount of \$1,219,314.05, including GST.

## SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work includes replacing the Robson Creek culvert crossing at 103A Avenue and 123A Street because it has eroded, constructing a sediment trap and daylighting a portion of the existing storm pipe connecting Robson Creek to the Manson Canal. The daylighting section will create a new open channel within City owned property that will provide new fish habitat in the area. Other work include the Bear Creek enhancement work at 78<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 144<sup>th</sup> Street. This work is for construction of an off-channel pond and marsh areas for the restoration and enhancement of habitat due to development in the Chimney Hill area. In addition, a culvert at the 8300 Block of 196<sup>th</sup> Street has deteriorated and eroded and will be replaced with a twin 1800 x 1200 box culvert. The new culvert will also provide additional capacity for future development.

Construction is expected to start in July, 2005, and be completed by September, 2005.

## TENDER RESULTS

Because of the nature of this work tenders for this project were by invitation only, from the Council-approved pre-qualified list for this type of work.

Tenders for Contract M.S. 4805-001-11 were received on June 23, 2005, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,040,000, including GST.

## EVALUATION

All tenders were reviewed by our consultant and the low bid found to represent reasonable value. Our consultant reviewed the tenders for legal and mathematical errors, and identified only minor mathematical extension errors by both bidders. The errors did not alter the tender results and Mission Contractors Ltd. is still the low bidder.. All the tenders submitted the required 10% bid bond, and signed and sealed the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond as stipulated in the contract. Mission Contractors Ltd., has no outstanding claims or legal issues with the City and their previous works have been satisfactory.

## **FUNDING**

Funding is available within the approved Engineering Budget.
