RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 1705-014-11 be awarded to the low bidder, Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd., in the amount of \$8,510,928.20, including GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work under this contract involves road works on the following Arterial roads:

<u>Fraser Highway: 17900 Block – 18500 Block – Widening to 4 lanes plus left turn bays/landscape medians, paving, curbs, sidewalks/multi-use paths, waterworks, storm sewer, street lighting, utility relocations and a traffic signal installation.</u>

<u>184 Street: 67 Avenue – 70 Avenue – Widening to 4 lanes plus left turn bays/landscape medians, paving, curbs, sidewalks, waterworks, storm sewer, street lighting, utility relocations, landscape medians and a traffic signal installation.</u>

Construction is expected to start July 18, 2005, and be completed in 2006.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1705-014-11 were received on June 28, 2005, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$9,650,000.00 including GST.

EVALUATION

All tenders were reviewed by our consultant. All the tenders submitted the required 10% bid bond, and signed and sealed the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 300 days as stipulated in the contract. Aggressive Roadbuilders Ltd. have completed similar projects for the City and are qualified to do this project. Their subcontractors have satisfactorily completed similar projects for the City in recent years and we have also found them to be qualified and acceptable.

FUNDING

Funding for this project is primarily from TransLink Major Capital Funds, with some funding from the City for City related works (i.e., water main replacement on Fraser Highway and 184 Street upgrading). The funding provided by TransLink is \$7,653,300 for the Fraser Highway component of the works, with the balance from the City's approved Engineering budget for the 184 Street section and other non-TransLink related costs.
