SUBJECT:	Contract Award - M.S. 4805-005/11 Delta Aggregates Ltd.				

### RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 4802-002-41 be awarded to Delta Aggregates Ltd. for an amount of \$809,482.12 including GST.

### BACKGROUND

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This contract is for a detention pond excavation and using the material to build the last lift of the Upper Serpentine Dykes. Under Development Permit 01-0198-00, the first phase of Pond "E" in the East Clayton NCP was constructed. More recently, lands required for completion of the pond were secured. In order for the City to provide stormwater controls for the area and also secure appropriate dyke material for completion of the Serpentine dykes, the City has opted to build the pond expansion this summer

#### DISCUSSION

Due to the relatively small size of the contract, short time line and urgency of this project we requested quotes from all the bidders this years dyke contracts. Each of these four contractors is on the City's approved contractor list for dyke and in-stream works and has shown their competitiveness for this type of work. Four Contractors were asked to submit quotations for the work with the results as follows:

## **EVALUATION**

The engineering's pre-quotation estimate was \$803,000.00. All quotations were checked for legal or mathematical errors and were found to be in order. Delta Aggregates Ltd. is the low bidder and has no outstanding claims or legal claims or legal issues with the City. Their past performance with the City on similar work has been excellent. We, therefore, are recommending that Delta Aggregates Ltd. be awarded the work.
