SUBJECT: Land Acquisition for the Holland Park Expansion

(13527 - 98B Avenue)

RECOMMENDATION

That Council authorize the acquisition of 13527 - 98B Avenue (PID No. 005-513-987) for future parkland as an addition to Holland Park.

DISCUSSION

1. Future Plan for Holland Park

The Parks, Recreation and Culture Department is redeveloping Holland Park into a special events site and Surrey's first major urban park as part of the Whalley Revitalization Strategy. To facilitate the expansion and redevelopment of Holland Park, a total of 17 properties adjacent to the park have been identified for acquisition, seven of which have been acquired to date.

The subject property is located on the north side of 98B Avenue and comprises one of 15 contiguous residential properties abutting the south side of the park. The remaining nine properties earmarked for acquisition are located on the south side of Holland Park, adjacent to the King George Highway or fronting 98B Avenue.

2. Property Location: 13527 - 98B Avenue

The subject property is located south of Holland Park, at the east end of the block on the north side of 98B Avenue. The improved site has a total area of 8,280 ft.² and contains a 1,109 ft.², one-storey, full-basement home considered to be in fair condition.

3. Zoning, Official Community Plan Designation, and Land Use

The subject property is zoned Single Family Residential (RF) and designated as Multiple Residential on the City of Surrey Official Community Plan. The Highest and Best Use of the subject property is as a site for the existing single family dwelling.

4. Contract of Purchase and Sale

City staff have negotiated a Contract of Purchase and Sale Agreement with the owners, based on an independent appraisal, subject to Council approval by November 29, 2005. Completion of the sale is to take place upon registration on December 20, 2005.

CONCLUSION

The terms of this agreement are considered reasonable. This acquisition is required to provide necessary land for the

proposed expansion and enhancement of Holland Park.
