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## RECOMMENDATIONS

1. That Contract M.S. 1705-016-11 be awarded to the low bidder, Imperial Paving Limited, in the amount of \$434,774.17 (including GST); and
2. That Council set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 1705-016-11 to \$456,512.88 (including GST).

## SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work under this contract involves road works on the following Arterial roads:

King George Highway @ 94A Avenue – Installation of full traffic signal to replace existing pedestrian signal. Includes modifications to and extension of centre median on King George Highway from 94A Avenue southerly. Also includes minor widening on 94A Avenue to permit installation of left turn lane at King George Highway.

96 Avenue: 13500 Block to 137B Street – Installation of a pedestrian signal fronting the main access to Surrey Memorial Hospital. Includes installation and extension of raised medians from a point west of King George Highway to 137B Street.

Construction is expected to start in early April and be completed in June 2006.

## TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1705-016-11 were received on February 14, 2005, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$400,000.00 including GST.

## EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed all tenders. All the tenders submitted the required 10% bid bond, and signed and sealed the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Imperial Paving Limited, has provided Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 50 working days as stipulated in the contract. Imperial Paving Limited have completed similar projects for the City and are qualified to do this project. Their sub-contractors have satisfactorily completed similar projects for the City in recent years and we have also found them to be qualified and acceptable.

## FUNDING

Funding for this project is from the City's approved Engineering budget.
