RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. That Contract M.S. 1706-002-11 be awarded to the low bidder, TAG Construction Ltd. Limited, in the amount of \$1,815, 805.09 (including GST); and
- 2. That Council set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 1706-002-11 to \$1,910,000.00 (including GST).

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work under this contract involves road works on the following Arterial roads:

<u>West Whalley Ring Road: Gateway Drive to King George Highway</u> – New Construction of West Whalley Ring Road to ultimate cross-section. These works will complete the connection of West Whalley Ring Road from 108 Avenue to King George Highway

<u>West Whalley Ring Road @ King George Highway</u> – Installation of a new full traffic signal.

Construction is expected to start in late May/early June and be completed later this Summer.

EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed all tenders. All the tenders submitted the required 10% bid bond, and signed and sealed the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, TAG Construction Ltd., has provided Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 45 working days as stipulated in the contract. TAG Construction Ltd. has completed similar projects for the City and are qualified to do this project. Their sub-contractors have satisfactorily completed similar projects for the City in recent years and we have also found them to be qualified and acceptable.

FUNDING

Funding for this project is from the City's approved Engineering budget.
