SUBJECT: Contract Award M.S. 4806-001-21, Double M Excavating Ltd.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 4806-001-21 to the low bidder, Double M Excavating Ltd., in the amount of \$3,231,149.33 including GST.
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 4806-001-21 in the amount of \$3,393,000.00

## SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 4806-001-21 involves the relocation of Eugene Creek, the excavation of East Clayton Pond A, and the construction of Upper Serpentine Dykes.

Using the excavated material from the pond, the contractor will build the Eugene Creek Dykes and raise the Serpentine Dykes. The new Eugene Creek channel will have dykes on both sides and relocation of the creek will increase flow capacity allowing further upstream development in the area. Under this Contract, the final lift of dyke material will also be placed along the Upper Serpentine River dykes.

## TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the above contract were received on June 13, 2006, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$3,400,000 including GST.

# **EVALUATION**

Our consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. There were minor arithmetic errors; however, they did not alter the tender results. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Double M Excavating Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 120 working days as stipulated in the contract. Double M Excavating Ltd.'s past performance with the City has been satisfactory, and have no outstanding legal claims against the City. We, therefore, are recommending that Double M Excavating Ltd. be awarded the work.

## **FUNDING**

Funding is available within the approved drainage budget.
