SUBJECT: Contract Award M.S. 4806-002-11, Delta Aggregates Ltd.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 4806-002-11 to the low bidder, Delta Aggregates Ltd. in the amount of \$767,482.27, including GST.
2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 4806-002-11 in the amount of \$850,000.00.

SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 4806-001-11 involves various instream works that involve the construction of a diversion channel from Sam Hill Creek to divert high flows from the creek to improve the conveyance for the existing creek. The contract also involves erosion protection of the banks for Cub Creek to protect private properties. The contract will also include the cleaning of three existing sediment traps located at the Upper Serpentine River, Surrey Lake, and the Davidson Pond.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the above contract were received on July 18, 2006, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$700,000.00 including GST.

EVALUATION

Our Consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. There were minor arithmetic errors; however, they did not alter the tender results. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Delta Aggregates Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 60 working days as stipulated in the contract. Delta Aggregates Ltd.'s past performance with the City has been satisfactory, and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. We, therefore, are recommending that Delta Aggregates Ltd. be awarded the work.

FUNDING

Funding is available with the approved drainage budget.
