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## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1707-006-11 to Winvan Paving Ltd. in the amount of \$1,065,676.30 including 6% GST; and
2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 1707-006-11 at \$1,140,000.00 including 6% GST.

## SCOPE OF WORK

## TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1707-006-11 were received on July 13, 2007, with the results as follows:

<i>Contractor</i>	<i>Tender Amount with GST</i>
1. Winvan Paving Ltd.	\$1,065,676.30
2. Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$1,093,141.96

While a number of contractors expressed interest in this project, only two bids were received. This is probably a reflection of the current high level of construction activity, with most contractors being fully engaged on other projects.

## EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. Both submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Winvan Paving Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 75 working days as stipulated in the contract. Winvan's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. We, therefore, recommend that Winvan Paving Ltd. be awarded the work.

## FUNDING

Funding is available within the approved Engineering budget.
