RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1708-008-11 to Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic (CB) in the amount of \$2,097,104.10 (including 5% GST); and
2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 1708-008-11 at \$2,265,000.00 (including 5% GST).

SCOPE OF WORK

This contract includes arterial paving, arterial patching and minor projects at various locations throughout Surrey.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for Contract M.S. 1708-008-11 were received on May 21, 2008, with the results as follows:

1. Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic (CB)	\$2,097,104.10
2. Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$2,223,125.10
3. Winvan Paving Ltd.	\$2,325,196.39

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$2,200,000 (including 5% GST).

EVALUATION

Our consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Columbia Bitulithic (CB), has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 80 working days as stipulated in the contract. CB's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. We, therefore, recommend that CB be awarded Contract M.S. 1708-008-11.

FUNDING

Funding is available within the approved Engineering budget.
