**SUBJECT: Contract Award M.S. 4802-002-61, Delta Aggregates Ltd. – Dyke Construction**

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## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 4802-002-61 for the placement of fill material on dykes along the Serpentine River to the low bidder, Delta Aggregates Ltd., in the amount of \$1,599,420.51, including GST.
2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 4802-002-61 at \$1,850,000 including GST.

## **SCOPE OF WORK**

Tender Package D02/02 relates to the work of placing the last few lifts of fill material to raise the dykes along the Serpentine River, from 64 Avenue to 56 Avenue.

These works are components of the Serpentine-Nicomekl Flood Control Project. Contractors from the Council-approved list (pre-qualified contractors) for Lowland Dyke Construction works were invited to submit tenders for this package. The work will reduce the frequency and duration of flooding experienced by the lowlands adjoining the Serpentine River in this section.

The work is expected to start by the second week of July and be completed by October 31, 2008.

## TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the above contract were received on June 17, 2008, with the results as follows:

2. Double M Excavating Ltd.	\$2,247,948.45	No Change

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,810,000 including GST.

## EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Delta Aggregates Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work by October 31, 2008, as stipulated in the contract. Delta Aggregates Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Delta Aggregates Ltd. be awarded Contract number M.S. 4802-002-61.

## FUNDING

Funding is available within the approved Engineering budget.
