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## RECOMMENDATION

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1708-004-11 to Trans-Western Electric Ltd. in the amount of \$555,081.45 (including 5% GST); and
2. Set the expenditure authorization for Contract M.S. 1708-004-11 at \$610,600.00 (including 5% GST).

## SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 1708-004-11 includes the following work:

These works involve installation of pedestrian signals and overhead signage for improved safety at various pedestrian crossing locations across the City. These works are being

funded from the Local Roads and Traffic Safety Funds. The work is expected to start October 20 and be completed by December 31, subject to weather conditions.

## **TENDER RESULTS**

Tenders for the above contract were received on September 25, 2008, as follows:

1. Trans-Western Electric Ltd.	\$555,081.45
2. Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$612,754.80

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$679,800 (including 5% GST).

## **EVALUATION**

The City's consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. Both submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Trans-Western Electric Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 50 working days as stipulated in the contract. Trans-Western Electric Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory and they have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Trans-Western Electric Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1708-004-11.

## **FUNDING**

Funding for this contract is available in the approved Engineering capital budget from the Local Roads and Traffic Safety Funds.
