RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1709-009-11 to Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic (CBL) in the amount of \$850,253.25, including GST; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1709-009-11 at \$920,000, including Contingency and GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

This construction package covered under this Contract consists of general repaying and patching on Arterial roads at the following locations. A map that illustrates the referenced locations is attached as Appendix I.

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,000,000, including GST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tenders for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, CBL, has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 60 working days, as stipulated in the contract. CBL's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that CBL be awarded Contract M.S. 1709-009-11.

FUNDING

Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2009 Budget.
