# RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1708-004-21 to Imperial Paving Ltd. in the amount of \$602,995.05, including GST; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1708-004-21 at \$663,000.00, including GST.

# **SCOPE OF WORK**

The work covered under this Contract includes intersection and traffic signal improvements at the following locations (Appendix I contains a map that illustrates each of the listed locations):

# **EVALUATION**

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond and agreed to complete the work within 50 working days. Imperial's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Imperial Paving Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1708-004-21.


