SUBJECT: Cultural Spaces Canada Funding for Expansion to Vault at Surrey Art Gallery

RECOMMENDATION

The Parks, Recreation and Culture Department and the Finance and Technology Department recommend that the Finance Committee recommend that Council:

- 1. Receive this report for information; and
- 2. Authorize the use of \$122,600 of capital funding from the Legacy Fund to match a \$122,519 grant from the Canadian Heritage Cultural Spaces of Canada Program for the purposes of expanding the storage vault at the Surrey Art Gallery.

DISCUSSION

The City of Surrey in partnership with the Surrey Art Gallery Association has been awarded a matching grant from Cultural Spaces Canada to expand the Surrey Art Gallery's vault that is used for the storage of the City's permanent collection of artworks. The Cultural Spaces Canada funding program is focused on improving the physical conditions for artistic creativity, presentation and exhibition. It is intended to support the renovation and expansion/construction of arts and heritage facilities and the acquisition of specialized equipment as well as the preparation of feasibility studies for cultural infrastructure projects.

The Surrey Art Gallery is an art museum, mandated to collect, preserve and exhibit contemporary artworks, and hold them as an asset in trust for the citizens of Surrey. The Gallery's vault meets national standards required for its "Class A" status, including strict conservation standards, environmental controls and security. An application was submitted to the Cultural Spaces Canada program for matching funding for a proposed expansion to the Art Gallery that would almost double the Gallery vault's storage capacity by adding a mezzanine level.

The project has an estimated total cost of \$245,037. This project was identified for implementation in 2013 in the 2010-2014 Five Year Financial Plan that was recently approved by Council. The funding application by the City was successful with the City having received a confirmation letter from the Honourable James Moore, Minister of Heritage, (See Appendix 1) that advises that \$122,519 in funding would be provided on a matching basis from Cultural Spaces

Canada. The grant requires that the project be completed by March 2011. Subject to Council approval of the recommendations of this report, the project will commence immediately and be completed by September, 2010.

Funding

The necessary matching funds are available in the Legacy Fund.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that the Finance Committee recommend that Council authorize the use of \$122,600 of capital funding from the Legacy fund to match a \$122,519 grant from the Canadian Heritage Cultural Spaces of Canada Program for the purposes of expanding the storage vault at the Surrey Art Gallery.
