SUBJECT: Request for Sponsorship - BC High School Bhangra Competition

RECOMMENDATION

The Finance and Technology Department recommends that the Finance Committee recommend that Council approve a sponsorship in the amount of \$1,500 from the Council Initiatives Fund for the BC High School Bhangra Competition being held at the Bell Centre on April 25th, 2010.

BACKGROUND

On November 23, 2009, the Finance Committee approved the 2010 City Grants. Since that time, the City has received a funding request from the BC High School Bhangra Society requesting sponsorship from the City for the 4th Annual BC High School Bhangra Competition.

DISCUSSION

The BC High School Bhangra Society is hosting the 4th Annual High School Bhangra Competition at the Bell Centre for the Performing Arts on April 25th, 2010. This event will bring high school bhangra teams from around the province, including seven local schools, to Surrey for a one-day competition. A competition such as this engages students in a positive school-based activity, which leads to stronger connections to both their school and their community. Proceeds from this event will be used to provide educational scholarships to students.

The BC High School Bhangra Society has requested sponsorship from the City at one of four levels of sponsorship as follows:

1.	Presenting	\$10,000
2.	University - Gold Star	\$ 5,000
3.	High School - Silver Star	\$ 2,500
4.	Elementary School – Bronze Star	\$ 1,500

Each of the levels of sponsorship offers various benefits to the sponsoring organization. Details of each of the four levels of sponsorship are included in *Appendix A*.

The Grants Evaluation Committee has reviewed this request and finds that it does not meet the grants evaluation criteria as the organization acts as a general fund-raiser for, or makes grants to, various other groups or organizations, i.e. student scholarships (No. D-26(10)(f)). However, in

view of the potential benefits (economic and image-related) accruing to Surrey as a result of the competition being held in Surrey, it is considered reasonable for the City to sponsor this event. Funds for the sponsorship are available from the Council Initiatives Fund.

CONCLUSION

Assuming that Council accepts the Grants Evaluation Committee recommendation, the unallocated balance in the Council Initiatives Fund would be \$357,947, as documented in *Appendix B* and the unallocated funds remaining in the City Grant Budget will be as follows:


