SUBJECT: Stanley Cup Community Celebration in Surrey City Centre

RECOMMENDATION

The Parks, Recreation and Culture and Finance and Technology Departments recommend that Council:

- 1. receive this report as information; and
- 2. allocate \$5,000 from Council Initiatives Fund to support a community celebration involving the Stanley Cup in Surrey City Centre on the afternoon of July 14th.

BACKGROUND

The Mayor's Office has been advised that Mr. Colin Fraser, a member of the Chicago Blackhawks who were the Stanley Cup winners in 2010, would have the Stanley Cup on July 14th and that he would be available and would have the Stanley Cup available for display in North Surrey in the afternoon on that date. Colin played minor hockey with the Surrey Minor Hockey Association and played out of the North Surrey Arena.

DISCUSSION

In response to the opportunity to have the Stanley Cup in Surrey and to acknowledge Mr. Fraser's accomplishment, plans have been initiated to host a community celebration in North Surrey. The event is planned for the Plaza the north end of the Central City development fronting 102 Avenue. Event activities will include:

- Local musical entertainment;
- Greeting of guests including Mr. Fraser by the Mayor and Councillors;
- Greeting by Mr. Fraser;
- Display of the Stanley Cup;
- Street hockey;
- Children's activities:
- Site animation;
- Community BBQ with the Lions Club; and
- Photo opportunities with the Stanley Cup.

The public will be invited through advertisements in the local media as well as direct e-mail invitations to minor and adult ice sport organizations and the local business community.

Staff is working on the event with a number of community partners including: Blackwood Partners, the Surrey Downtown BIA, the Surrey Eagles, Surrey Minor Hockey and the Whalley Community Association.

The event will include a stage, sound system, entertainment, marketing and on-site security. To support the event an allocation of \$5000 from the Council Initiatives Fund is necessary.

CONCLUSION

Staff is working with a number of community partners to host a free family-focused celebration at the Central City Plaza on July 14th from 12 noon to 3 p.m. The event will feature a community BBQ hosted by the North Surrey Lions Club, free family activities and opportunities for photos with the Stanley Cup. It is recommended that Council allocate \$5,000 from Council Initiatives to support this event. A summary of the expenditures and remaining balance in Council Initiative Fund is outlined in Appendix A of this report assuming that Council approves the recommendations of this report.
