SUBJECT: Award of Contract for the Construction of the Expansion to the

**Fraser Heights Recreation Centre** 

#### RECOMMENDATION

The Planning and Development Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Approve the award of a contract to PAX Construction Ltd., as General Contractor, for the construction of the Fraser Heights Recreation Centre Expansion with a total value of \$4,501,516, excluding HST; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for the contract at \$4,850,000, excluding HST.

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to obtain Council approval to award a contract for the construction of an expansion to the Fraser Heights Recreation Centre.

### **BACKGROUND**

Council approved the construction of an expansion to the Fraser Heights Recreation Centre as part of the 2010 Capital budget. Early in 2010, a Request for Proposals ("RFP") was developed to obtain pre-construction services for this project. RFP #1220-30-25-10 was advertised on the City's website and posted the BC Bid Website. The RFP closed on July 7, 2010. Seventeen submissions were received. These are listed in Appendix I to this report. As a result of an evaluation process, it was determined that the proposal from PAX Construction Ltd. provided the best value. In August 2010, PAX Construction Ltd. was awarded an initial contract for pre-construction services for the project to assist with the evaluation of the design, scheduling and cost estimating of the project.

#### **Request for Quotes Process and Results**

Over the course of the Fall, under Invitation to Tender # 1220-20-01-10, each component related to the construction of this project has been tendered separately. The request for quotation process that has been followed is consistent with the City's competitive procurement policy. Invitations to quote each component were advertised on the City's website and posted on the BC Bid website. A list of the proponents who provided quotations for the construction services for the project are

listed in Appendix I. Appendix II lists the four lowest proponents that quoted each of the various components of the project. Under the construction management process, the general contractor who is awarded the construction services portion of the contract accepts the responsibility for the prices and risk associated with delivering the various components of the project that were quoted separately as listed in Appendix II.

Based on an evaluation of all the tenders, PAX Construction Ltd. represents the best overall value to the City for the construction of the Fraser Heights Recreation Centre Expansion project. The amount associated with the award of the contract as recommended in this report combines the low quote for each of the materials and trades components of the project with the General Contractor's fees, which is the "stipulated price" for the contract in the amount of \$4,501,516, excluding HST.

Funding in support of this contract is available within the Council-approved 2010 Capital budget.

#### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council approve the award of a contract to PAX Construction Ltd., as General Contractor, for the construction of the Fraser Heights Recreation Centre Expansion project with a total value of \$4,501,516, excluding HST, and set the expenditure authorization limit for the contract at \$4,850,000, excluding HST.
