SUBJECT: Golf Canada 2011 Canadian Junior Boys Golf Championship

#### RECOMMENDATION

The Finance & Technology Department recommends that Council approve financial support of \$10,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to the tournament organizers of Golf Canada's 2011 Canadian Junior Boys Golf Championship that is being held at the Morgan Creek Golf Course from August 1 to August 5, 2011.

### **BACKGROUND**

Golf Canada is the national sport organization for golf in Canada. Its goal is to encourage participation in the game of golf. Golf Canada conducts both amateur and professional championships, amateur programs and a variety of services across the country to help shape the present and future of golf in Canada. This year, the Canadian Junior Boys Championships will be held at Morgan Creek Golf Course from August 1 to August 5. The tournament organizers have requested financial support from the City in the amount of \$10,000, to assist with signage, player shuttle and communication expenses.

# **DISCUSSION**

This national event will bring together 156 of the highest calibre national junior golfers between the ages of 12 and 18 years along with fans, supporters, media, Golf Canada personnel, numerous volunteers from across the country and a select group of international golfers. The event will have national and international media coverage and will have economic benefit to local hotels, restaurants and retail outlets.

Morgan Creek Golf Course has donated their golf course to Golf Canada for the week; however, it is estimated that an additional \$65,000 will be required to support this event. The tournament organizers have requested a financial contribution of \$10,000 from the City to help off-set the costs associated with signage, player shuttles and communications for this event.

The City has funded sports events that help to provide broad public exposure for Surrey and attract attention from economic sectors important to the on-going development of a strong and healthy city. The Council Initiatives Fund has been used in these circumstances as the source for the City's financial support. Examples where the City has provided financial support includes the Canadian PGA City of Surrey Invitational Golf Tournament at Hazelmere Golf Course, the National Women's Under-18 Hockey Championship held at South Surrey Arena, the Canadian

Short Track Speed Skating Championships held at the South Surrey Arena and the 2010 Hargobind International Wrestling Championships held at the Guildford Recreation Centre.

Staff has reviewed the request and recommends that \$10,000 in financial support be provided from the Council Initiatives Fund to tournament organizers for the 2011 Canadian Junior Boys Golf Championship. The balance remaining in the Council Initiatives Fund assuming that Council approves the recommendation of this report is documented in Appendix "A".

### SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The 2011 Canadian Junior Boys Golf Championship will contribute to achieving the socio-cultural goals of the City's Sustainability Charter, namely, "Promote Active Living and Cultural Opportunities".

# **CONCLUSION**

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council approve financial support of \$10,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to the tournament organizers of Golf Canada's 2011 Canadian Junior Boys Golf Championship that is being held at the Morgan Creek Golf Course from August 1 to August 5, 2011.
