SUBJECT: Funding Request for the "Rick Hansen Many In Motion" Community

Celebration Event

RECOMMENDATION

The Parks, Recreation and Culture Department and the Finance and Technology Department recommend that the Finance Committee recommend that Council approve funding in the amount of \$2,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to offset some of the costs associated with the "Rick Hansen Many in Motion" Community Celebration that is being held at the Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex on Saturday, May 19, 2012.

BACKGROUND

The City of Surrey is an "official route" community for the 25th Anniversary Rick Hansen "Many In Motion" Relay. The Relay will arrive in Surrey on Saturday, May 19, 2012. As part of the activities that day, a community celebration event is being planned at the Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex.

The following provides some background information about the Relay:

- the Relay began on August 24, 2011 in Cape Spear, Newfoundland and Labrador and concludes in Vancouver, British Columbia on May 22, 2012;
- the Relay fully recreates the original "Man In Motion" cross-Canada tour, spanning 12,000 kilometres from coast-to-coast;
- the Relay is travelling through more than 600 communities, visiting every capital city in Canada and all provinces and territories and reaching more than 70% of the Canadian population;
- the Relay will engage approximately 7,000 Medal-Bearers difference makers in their own right and is covering an average of 40 to 80 kilometres a day, making its way across the country with Medal-Bearers passing a single Rick Hansen Medal from one Medal-Bearer to the next; and
- All Canadians (13 years and up) were able to apply to become a Medal-Bearer through an online contest at www.RickHansenRelay.com.

DISCUSSION

As mentioned above a community celebration event in honour of the "Rick Hansen Many in Motion Relay" is being planned for the Surrey Sport and Leisure Complex from noon – 3:00 pm on Saturday, May 19th and will include:

- arrival of the City of Surrey official Medal Bearer, Stan Leyenhorst;
- presentations and entertainment by the Rick Hansen Foundation Many in Motion Relay Team;
- disability sport demonstrations by Sportability BC;
- children's activities, crafts, and face painting; and
- entertainment by local youth musicians and dancers.

Parks, Recreation and Culture Departmental staff is working with community agencies to plan this community celebration. With a view to ensuring adequate funding for the celebration, it is proposed that \$2,000 be provided to the event from the Council Initiatives Fund. The event budget is documented in Appendix "A".

Status of the Council Initiatives Fund

Appendix "B" documents the balance in the Council Initiatives Fund on the assumption that Council will approve the recommendation of this report.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The Rick Hansen Many In Motion Relay supports the goals and objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter by encouraging connections, volunteerism and citizen engagement; more particularly the following action items in the Charter:

- SC₅: Plan for the Social Well Being of Surrey Residents;
- SC7: Participation in Leisure Programs;
- SC8: Municipal Outreach, Public Education and Awareness; and
- SC13: Create a Fully Accessible City.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that the Finance Committee recommend that Council approve funding in the amount of \$2,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to offset some of the costs associated with the "Rick Hansen Many in Motion" Community Celebration that is being held at the Surrey Sport & Leisure Complex on Saturday, May 19, 2012.
