SUBJECT: Award of Contract M.S. 1712-006-11

Widening of King George Boulevard from 32 Avenue Diversion to Anderson

Creek

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1712-006-11 to Mainland Civil Works Inc. for the construction of the widening of King George Boulevard (KGB) between 32 Avenue Diversion and Anderson Creek in the amount of \$3,624,990.88 including HST; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1712-006-11 at \$4,150,000.00 including contingency and HST.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction work related to this Contract consists of road widening, intersection improvements, traffic signal installations and street lighting at the locations listed in the following table and as illustrated on the map attached as Appendix I. Although the major component of the contract is the widening of KGB as illustrated on the map attached as Appendix II, the contract also includes street light installation along KGB between Highway 10 and Colebrook Road and the installation of a new traffic signal at the intersection of 104 Avenue and Old Yale Road.

The contract work is expected to start in August 2012 and be completed by the end of December 2012.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on July 10, 2012 with the following results:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$3,921,417.00 including HST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. There was one arithmetic error that had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Mainland Civil Works Inc., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 100 working days as stipulated in the contract. Mainland Civil Works Inc.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Mainland Civil Works Inc. be awarded Contract M.S. 1712-006-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CHARTER/CONSIDERATIONS

The project will enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs. In particular, the project will assist in achieving the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter; more particularly, the following Charter scope action items:

- SC13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

FUNDING


Funding for the subject contract is available in the approved 2012 Capital Budget.
