SUBJECT: Award of Contract for Construction of an Addition to the South Surrey

Recreation Centre

RECOMMENDATION

The Planning and Development Department and Finance & Technology Department recommend that Council:

- 1. Approve the award of a contract as generally described in this report to Heatherbrae Builders Co. Ltd., as General Contractor, to construct the South Surrey Recreation Centre Addition project at a total base value of the contract being \$6,666,884.00, excluding HST/GST; and
- 2. Authorize an expenditure authority for this contract of \$7,000,000.00, including contingencies but excluding HST/GST.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to award a contract related to the construction of an addition to the South Surrey Recreation Centre.

BACKGROUND

Council approved the construction of the subject addition to the South Surrey Recreation Centre as part of the City's Capital budget.

A Request for Expressions of Interest ("RFEOI") was developed for the purpose of obtaining a General Contractor for pre-construction services for the project and to allow the City to lock-in prices related to the general conditions associated with construction of the project and for overall management of the construction project. The City issued RFEOI #1220-030-2012-022 by advertising it on the City's website and posting it on the BC Bid Website. Six submissions were received by the close of the process on May 24, 2012. The proponents are listed in Appendix I. Each of the submissions was evaluated in relation to the following criteria:

- Experience;
- Reputation;
- Expertise; and
- Cost.

It was concluded that the submission from Heatherbrae Builders Co. Ltd. provided the best value for the City. As a result in September 2012, Heatherbrae Builders Co. Ltd. was awarded a contract for pre-construction services for the project that included assisting with the evaluation of the design, scheduling and cost estimating.

DISCUSSION

An Invitation to Tender (# 1220-030-2012-36A) was issued for the project under which each component of the project was tendered separately. This process follows the City's competitive procurement policy. The Invitations to Tender for each component of the project were published on the City's website and posted on the BC Bid website.

Appendix II lists the quotations that were received in relation to each component that is required to complete the construction of the project. The low quote for each of component of the project is being combined with the low quote of all other components under a stipulated price contract which is proposed to be awarded to a General Contractor, who will then take on the risk of ensuring that all of the work related to project is completed at the stipulated price.

Given the quality of the work that Heatherbrae Builders Co. Ltd. has delivered under the preconstruction services contract and their proposal with respect to construction services (i.e., General Contractor services), staff is satisfied that Heatherbrae represents the best overall value to the City in relation to providing General Contractor services for the project.

When the costs associated with all of the trade components are combined with charges related to the General Contractor services under a stipulated price contract, the total contract value is \$6,666,884.00, excluding HST/GST.

Funding for this contract is available within the Council-approved Capital Budget.

Construction of the project it expected to commence mid February 2013 and be completed by Spring of 2014.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council:

- Approve the award of a contract as generally described in this report to Heatherbrae Builders Co. Ltd., as General Contractor, to construct the South Surrey Recreation Centre Addition project at a total base value of the contract being \$6,666,884.00, excluding HST/GST; and
- Authorize an expenditure authority for this contract of \$7,000,000.00, including contingencies but excluding HST/GST.
