SUBJECT: Award of Contract M.S. 1713-001-21

Arterial Road Paving at Various Locations

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1713-001-21 to Winvan Paving Ltd. in the amount of \$4,335,506.44, including GST, for arterial road paving at various locations throughout the City; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1713-001-21 at \$5,073,000.00, including contingency and GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this Contract consists of road paving and patching on arterial roads at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached as Appendix I:

The contract work is expected to start on April 29, 2013 and be completed by August 30, 2013.

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$4,989,000, including GST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Winvan Paving Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 90 working days as stipulated in the contract. Winvan Paving Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Winvan Paving Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1713-001-21.

CONTRACT SCOPE/PRICE CONSIDERATIONS

The unit price for asphalt paving offered by Winvan Paving Ltd. in their bid is very favourable. The terms of the contract, as tendered, allow for the scope of work to be increased by the City. Staff has identified other priority locations for arterial pavement rehabilitation with a view to capitalizing on the favourable pricing in this contract and the recommended expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1713-001-21 has been set at \$5,073,000.00 to reflect this intention.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed road construction works will prolong the life of the City's existing road infrastructure as well as improve the travel characteristics of the subject roads (better ride and less noise) for both motorists and cyclists. This contract will assist in achieving the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter, which include efficiently moving people and goods, not just vehicles. In alignment with the goals of the Sustainability Charter, the project will also enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities, while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs and economic development. In particular, the project supports the following Charter Scope actions:

- SC 13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN 13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

FUNDING


Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2013 Budget.
