Intersection Improvements at King George Boulevard and 16 Avenue

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1713-016-11 to B&B Contracting Ltd. in the amount of \$2,094,600.00 including GST, for road construction and intersection improvements at the intersection of King George Boulevard and 16 Avenue; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1713-016-11 at \$2,350,000.00 including contingency and GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Ministry of Transportation & Infrastructure is constructing the Highway 99/16 Avenue interchange in partnership with the City of Surrey. Once the interchange is completed additional traffic is expected at the adjacent intersection of 16 Avenue with King George Boulevard. In conjunction with the interchange project, the City has committed to constructing improvements at and in the vicinity of this intersection.

This Contract involves road widening and intersection improvements at the intersection of 16 Avenue with King George Boulevard including new curbs and sidewalks, road construction and a traffic signal.

The contract work is expected to commence by September 23, 2013, and be completed by January 23, 2014.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on August 27, 2013, with the following results:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$2,292,000.00 including GST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, B&B Contracting Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 80 working days as stipulated in the contract. B&B Contracting Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that B&B Contracting Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1713-016-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The project will enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities, while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs. In particular, the project supports the Sustainability Charter Scope action items related to:

- SC 13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN 13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

FUNDING

Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2013 Budget.
