SUBJECT: Sponsorship Opportunities - Darpan Extraordinary and Heritage BC -

Funding Request

RECOMMENDATION

The Finance and Technology Department recommends that the Finance Committee recommend that Council approve from the Council Initiatives Fund:

- a sponsorship contribution of \$2,500 in support of the 5th Annual Darpan Extraordinary Achievement Awards, which will include tickets for members of Council who are planning to attend this event; and
- a sponsorship contribution of \$2,500 in support of the Heritage BC Annual Conference & Awards Ceremony.

DISCUSSION

Darpan Extraordinary Achievement Awards:

Darpan Magazine will host the 5th Annual Darpan Extraordinary Achievement Awards on September 19, 2014 at the Aria Banquet Hall. This event will bring together 700 attendees who include key stakeholders, influential community and business leaders and dignitaries for an evening of networking and philanthropology while recognizing individuals or groups who have reflected their South Asian heritage in a remarkable way. The awards are community driven and presented to ten recipients in the categories of Community Crusader, Young Wonder, Industry Marvel, Corporate Engagement and more. The evening will also consist of a keynote speaker, entertainment, a meal and awards presentation. Darpan Magazine is requesting that the City consider providing a sponsorship contribution to support this event. Staff is recommending that Council consider supporting this event through a table sponsorship of \$2,500. This level of sponsorship will include recognition in the event program and a ten person table which will allow members of Council to attend the event.

Heritage BC Annual Conference & Awards Gala:

Heritage BC will be holding their annual conference on September 26 and 27 in Cloverdale. This conference will bring together heritage professionals from diverse backgrounds and experiences

for mutual support, education and inspiration. This year's theme is "building bridges" to demonstrate our commitment to link heritage conservation across diverse interests. Heritage BC is requesting that the City consider providing a sponsorship contribution to support this event. Staff is recommending that Council consider providing a gold level sponsorship of \$2,500. This level of sponsorship will include recognition in the event program, acknowledgement posted at the venue and on the Heritage BC Website, a 10 x 10 booth in the Heritage Marketplace, two conference passes and two tickets to the awards gala.

These sponsorships do not satisfy the evaluation criteria for a City grant as stipulated in the City Grant Policy since the events are fund-raisers for another organization; however, Council has previously provided funding to similar events through the Council Initiatives Fund.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that the Finance Committee recommend that Council approve from the Council Initiatives Fund:

- a sponsorship contribution of \$2,500 in support of the 5th Annual Darpan Extraordinary Achievement Awards, which will include ten tickets for members of Council who are planning to attend this event; and
- a sponsorship contribution of \$2,500 in support of the Heritage BC Annual Conference & Awards Ceremony.
