SUBJECT: Award of Contract M.S. 1714-005-11

Widening of 32 Avenue Between 188 Street and 192 Street

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1714-005-11 to Imperial Paving Limited for the construction of the widening of 32 Avenue between 188 Street and 192 Street, in the amount of \$2,969,278.71 including GST; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1714-005-11 at \$3,270,000.00 including contingency and GST.

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

The work associated with the subject contract is for the widening to four lanes of 32 Avenue between 188 Street and 192 Street. The location of the contract works is illustrated on the map, which is attached as Appendix I to this report. These works will include raised landscaped median and intersection improvements.

The contract work is expected to start in April 2014 and be completed by the end of October 2014.

## TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on February 27, 2014, with the following results:

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The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$3,865,000.00 including GST.

### **EVALUATION**

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. Both submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Imperial Paving Limited, has provided a Consent of Surety for Performance Bond, Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 135 working days as stipulated in the contract. Imperial Paving Limited's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Imperial Paving Limited be awarded Contract M.S. 1714-005-11.

## SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The project will enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities, while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs. The project supports the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter; in particular, the following action items:

- SC13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN13: Enhancing the Public Realm.


