 SUBJECT: **Award of Contract M.S. 1714-009-11**
2014 School Sidewalk Program at Various Locations

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1714-009-11 to Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic in the amount of \$2,203,425.00, including GST, for the 2014 School Sidewalk Program; and
2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1714-009-11 at \$2,424,000.00, including GST and contingency.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this contract consists of works at twelve (12) locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix I. The works being constructed include traffic calming measures, pedestrian crossings, sidewalks and school pick-up and drop off (PUDO) areas. The first ten (10) sites included in this contract are part of the City's Safe and Active School Program which forms part of the City's investment of over \$4 million since 2013 to improve safety for children around our schools.

The contract work is expected to start on July 7, 2014, and be completed by September 30, 2014, with the school work sites to be constructed before September 2014.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on June 5, 2014 with the following results:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$2,052,000 including GST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. There was one arithmetic error that had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic, has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 60 working days, as stipulated in the contract. Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic be awarded Contract M.S. 1714-009-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The work associated with this contract will assist in achieving the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter related to safely and efficiently moving people and goods, not just vehicles, and promoting active living. The project will also act to enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs. More particularly, the project supports the following Sustainability Charter scope action items:

- SC 13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN 13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

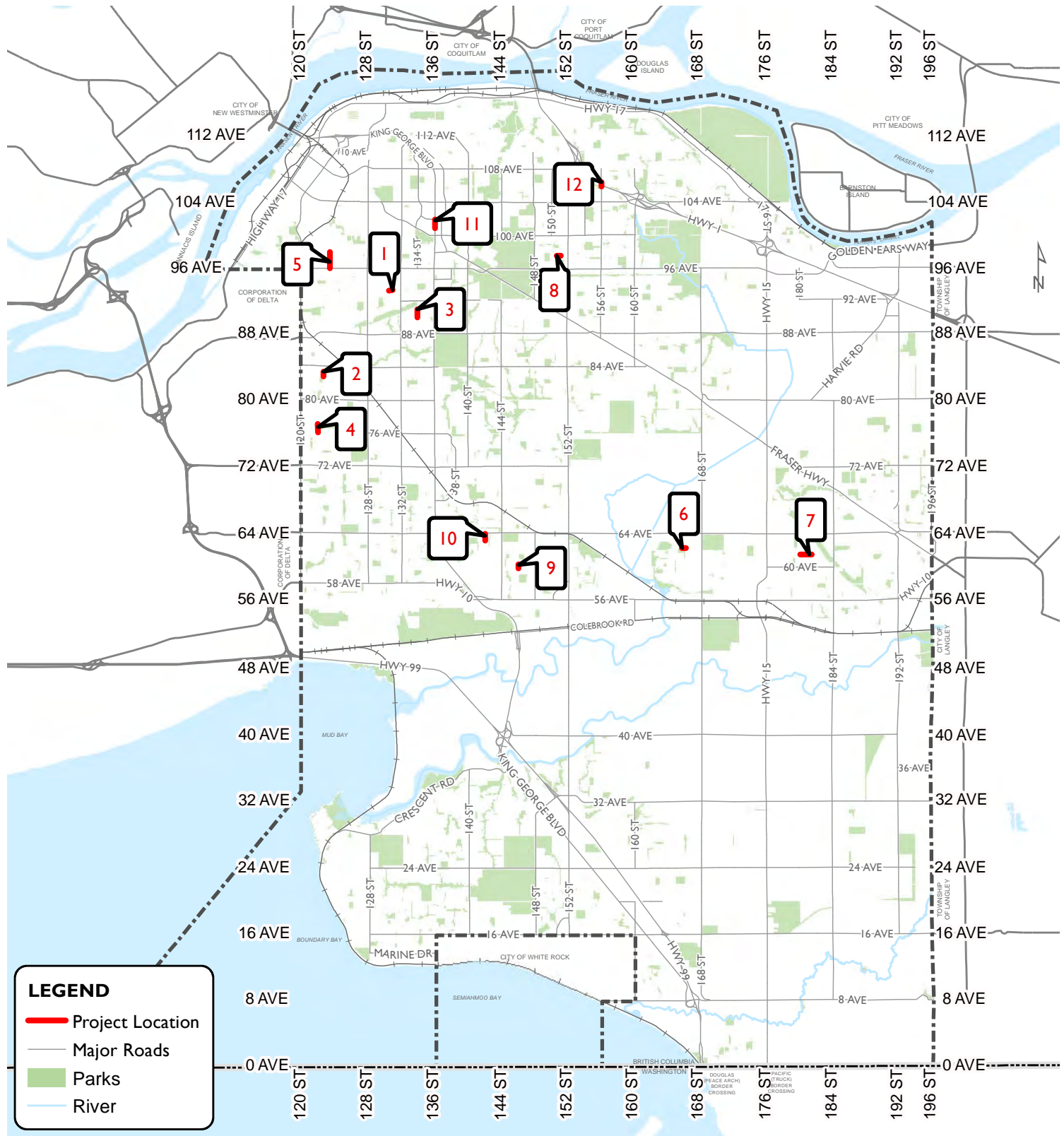
Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2014 Transportation Budget.
