**2014 Non-Arterial Patching Program**

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1714-010-11 to Winvan Pacing Ltd. in the amount of \$1,766,606.52, including GST, for 2014 Non-Arterial Patching Program; and
2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1714-010-11 at \$1,943,000.00 including GST and contingency.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

The construction package related to this contract consists of road patching and paving as part of the Non-Arterial Road Rehabilitation Program at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix I:

The contract work is expected to start on July 21, 2014, and be completed by September 30, 2014.

**TENDER RESULTS**

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on June 17, 2014 with the following results:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,767,000.00 including GST.

## EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Winvan Paving Ltd. has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 50 working days, as stipulated in the contract. Winvan Paving Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Winvan Paving Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1714-010-11.

## SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed road construction works will prolong the life of the City's existing road infrastructure as well as improve the travel characteristics of the subject roads (better ride and less noise) for both motorists and cyclists. This contract will assist in achieving the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter, which include efficiently moving people and goods, not just vehicles. In alignment with the goals of the Sustainability Charter, the project will also enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities, while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs and economic development. In particular, the project supports the following Charter Scope actions:

- SC 13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN 13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

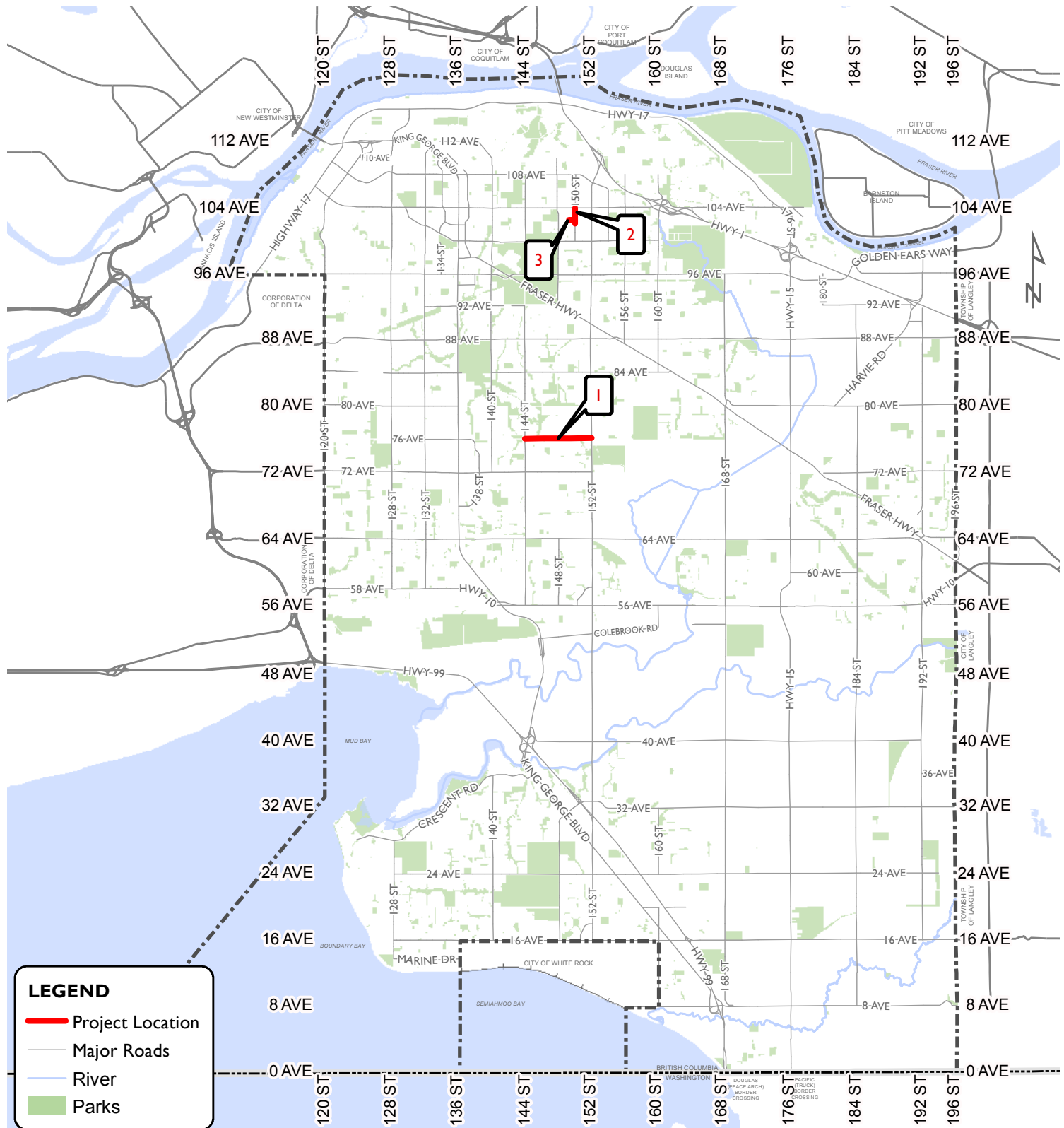
Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2014 Transportation Budget.
