SUBJECT: Increase of Taxi Licenses

RECOMMENDATION

The Legal Services Division recommends that Council:

- That Council adopt the amendments to the City of Surrey Vehicle for Hire By-law, 1999, No. 13610 which would authorize the one time increase of 14 taxicab licenses from 305 to 319 based on the approval of the licenses by the Passenger Transportation Board ("PTB");
- 2 Approve an amendment to the City of Surrey Vehicle For Hire By-law, 1999, No. 13610, as documented in Appendix "I" of this report;
- 3 Authorize the City Clerk to bring forward the related by-law amendment as described in this report for the required readings and adoption.

INTENT

The intent of this report is to add 14 licenses and to introduce amendments to City of Surrey Vehicle for Hire By-law that if approved, will facilitate the approval process of taxicab licenses between City of Surrey and the PTB.

DISCUSSION

In 1999, the Vehicle for Hire By-law, 1999, No. 13610, was approved by Council. Since that time there has been a substantial increase in population in the City. This created a demand for more taxicabs to service the public need. A consultation process was developed through meetings with the owners within the industry that resulted in an increase to the number of taxicab licenses approved since 1999. In addition, the meetings identified the need to address the application process of the Notice of Intent for an increase of taxicab licenses to the PTB and City of Surrey.

Under the current Vehicle for Hire By-law, the number of vehicles which may be licensed by the City of Surrey for use as a Class "A" Taxicab is limited to 305, and may only be increased by an application to the PTB, provided that a Motor Carrier License is held by the applicant.

The PTB has approved 14 additional licenses for Delta Sunshine Taxi Company operating in Surrey, and that company has requested an increase to their Class "A" taxicab licenses from the City of Surrey.

Currently the By-Law and Licensing and Transportation Division receives the Notice of Intent for an increase to the number of taxicabs after it has been reviewed by the PTB. The City must respond with any recommendations to the PTB within 30 days. The City responded in December 2014 in support of the application by the Delta Sunshine Taxi Company.

Staff are currently in consultation with the taxi industry to develop a new recommended streamlined process to address future taxi license increases. The new approval framework will require taxicab companies to submit the Notice of Intent for an increase to the number of taxicabs to By-Law and Licensing and Transportation Division prior to being submitted to the Passenger Transportation Board. This will provide staff the opportunity to review the Notice of Intent and consult with the taxi industry on their application. Any recommendations from the City will then be submitted at the same time with the Notice of Intent to the PTB.

This will provide the PTB the opportunity to have all of the information at the time of the submissions thus reducing the processing timelines.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, the Legal Services Division recommends that Council:

- That Council adopt the amendments to the City of Surrey Vehicle for Hire By-law, 1999, No. 13610 which would authorize the one time increase in taxicab licenses from 305 to 319 based on the approval of the licenses by the Passenger Transportation Board ("PTB");
- Approve an amendment to the City of Surrey Vehicle For Hire By-law, 1999, No. 13610, as documented in Appendix "I" of this report;
- Authorize the City Clerk to bring forward the related by-law amendment as described in this report for the required readings and adoption.
