## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1715-004-11 to A.C. Paving Company Ltd. in the amount of \$2,090,778.38, including GST, for the 2015 Sidewalk Construction: Package #2; and
- 2. Set expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1715-004-11 at \$2,300,000.00, including GST and contingency.

## **SCOPE OF WORK**

The construction package related to this Contract consists of sidewalks, curb bulges, and minor intersection improvements at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached as Appendix I. 16 of these 18 projects are part of the City's 2015 Safe and Active Schools Program.

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$2.1 Million, including GST.

## **EVALUATION**

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. There were two arithmetic errors that had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, and were signed and sealed on the Tender Form and Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, A.C. Paving Company Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for Performance Bond, Labour & Material Bond, WorkSafeBC Letter and agreed to complete the work within 110 working days, as stipulated in the contract. A post tender reference check was completed on A.C. Paving for past work completed, and the references indicate their work has been satisfactory for similar work. In addition, A.C. Paving Company Ltd. attended an interview with Surrey to specifically review their experience, staffing and available resources in order to complete a project of this size. A.C. Paving Company Ltd. provided their full commitment of all available resources in order to achieve the tight timeline necessary to complete this contract. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that A.C. Paving Company Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1715-004-11.

## **SUSTAINABILTIY CONSIDERATIONS**

This contract will assist in achieving the vision of the City's Sustainability Charter, which includes efficiently moving people and goods, not just vehicles, and promoting active living. In alignment with the goals of the Sustainability Charter, the project will also enhance the public realm by implementing street standards that minimize the negative impacts of transportation facilities on communities, while providing appropriate infrastructure in support of the City's transportation needs. In particular, the project supports the following Charter Scope actions:

- SC 13: Creating a Fully Accessible City; and
- EN 13: Enhancing the Public Realm.

## **FUNDING**


Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2015 Transportation Budget.
