Sponsorship Requests - Simon Fraser University (SFU) - Surrey

### RECOMMENDATION

The Finance and Technology Department recommends that Council approve from the Council **Initiatives Fund:** 

- 1. a sponsorship contribution of \$15,000 in support of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration: Surrey Campus Open House; and
- 2. a bursary contribution of \$10,000 in support of five \$2,000 bursaries, to be known as the City of Surrey Award.

### **BACKGROUND**

The 2015/2016 academic year has seen SFU begin to undertake a number of 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebrations. The City of Surrey has been invited to sponsor two initiatives that are specific to the Surrey Campus; SFU's 50th Anniversary Celebration: Surrey Campus Open House, scheduled for March 2, 2016 and the City of Surrey Award, which consists of five \$2,000 bursaries for students studying at the Surrey Campus.

### **DISCUSSION**

### SFU's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration: Surrey Campus Open House

On March 2, 2016, SFU will hold an open house that is expected to draw over 3,000 people to celebrate 50 years of SFU's academic and research excellence and engagement with the community, with a particular emphasis on the campus in Surrey. Through entertaining and interactive exhibits, displays, presentation and workshops, the public will learn about and be immersed in, the educational opportunities that are available to them at SFU and the Surrey Campus. SFU is requesting that the City participate as the Presenting Sponsor with a sponsorship of \$15,000. With this level of sponsorship, the City's name and logo will be featured in all even advertising, there would be an opportunity for the Mayor (or designate) to participate in the welcome address, a dedicated space would be provided for the City to showcase plans for future development and be included in media releases that would feature the City as a partner of the open house and an active partner with SFU in developing a socially, culturally and economically vibrant city.

### City of Surrey Award

This award will provide five SFU students, studying at the Surrey campus, with a \$2,000 bursary for a total contribution of \$10,000. There would be an opportunity for the City to announce the award at the open house on March  $2^{nd}$ , 2016. The recipients of the award will be announced in the fall of 2016, with an opportunity for the City of Surrey and SFU to jointly promote this initiative at events such as the SFU Presidents Gala.

While these sponsorships meet the evaluation criteria of the City Grant program, the funding requirements exceeds the capacity of that program. Council has previously provided supported various events at SFU from the Council Initiatives Fund, demonstrating the City's continuing commitment to SFU Surrey and to Surrey students.

### **Funding**

Appendix "II" attached to this report documents the balance in the Council Initiatives Fund based on an assumption that Council will approve the recommendations of this report.

### **CONCLUSION**

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that the Council approve from the Council Initiatives Fund:

- a sponsorship contribution of \$15,000 in support of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration: Surrey Campus Open House; and
- a bursary contribution of \$10,000 in support of five \$2,000 bursaries, to be known as the City of Surrey Award.

The Award will provide five SFU students studying at the Surrey campus with a \$2,000 bursary. The recipients of the Award will be announced in Fall 2016, with an opportunity for the City of Surrey and SFU to jointly promote this initiative at events such as the SFU President's Gala.

The City of Surrey's contribution will support the implementation and promotion of the Open House, and create a new award that will allow, and encourage, students to study at SFU's Surrey campus.

There is some time sensitivity to this request – for example, promotion of the Open House needs to commence as a soon as possible.


