SUBJECT: Award of Contract M.S. 1715-009-11

Bridgeview Drive Widening - Phase 1 Drainage and Preload Works

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 1715-009-11 to BD Hall Constructors Corporation in the amount of \$1,415,214.15, including GST, for the Bridgeview Drive Widening Phase 1 Drainage and Preload Works;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1715-009-11 at \$1,560,000.00 including GST and contingency; and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract M.S. 1715-009-11.

SCOPE OF WORK

In 2016, the City was successful in receiving \$3.0 million in funding from Transport Canada as part of the Asia Pacific Gateway Corridor Initiative for the widening of Bridgeview Drive from King George Boulevard to Highway 17 (South Fraser Perimeter Road).

The construction package related to this contract is Phase 1 of the road widening and consists primarily of constructing storm sewer mains and preload fill on 128 Street and Bridgeview Drive between 111 Avenue and Highway 17. The project extents are illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I". Phase 2 of the 4-lane widening is anticipated to be tendered in early 2017.

The contract work is expected to start August 2016 and be completed by November 2016.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on July 7, 2016 with the following results:

The Engineer's (WEB Engineering Ltd.) pre-tender estimate was \$2,215,610.00 including GST.

EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. There was one arithmetic error that had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, were signed on the Tender Form, and were initialed on the Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, BD Hall Constructors Corporation (Hall), has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 70 working days, as stipulated in the contract. BD Hall Constructors Corporation's past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that BD Hall Constructors Corporation be awarded Contract M.S. 1715-009-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The City is responsible for providing safe transportation networks to all road users. This relates to the Sustainability Charter's Public Safety theme and the overall goal of having a safe city to live, work, learn and play in. Specifically, this contract supports the following desired outcomes:

- Transportation Safety Dog: Transportation network supports and provides safe mobility for all ages and abilities; and
- Transportation Safety Doio: Surrey is part of a coordinated effort to reduce the risk of harm for all road users, with attention to those who are most vulnerable, including pedestrians and cyclists.

FUNDING


Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2016 Drainage and Transportation Budgets.
