RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract M.S. 4713-003-11 to Pedre Contractors Ltd. in the amount of \$2,399,250.00, including GST, for the West Newton Sanitary Sewer Construction;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 4713-003-11 at \$2,517,922.00, including contingency and GST; and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract M.S. 4713-003-11.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this contract includes the installation of sanitary sewer upgrades and abandonment of existing under capacity and aging sanitary sewers at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I".

The contract work is expected to start in October 2016 and be completed by the end of April 2017.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on August 31, 2016 with the following results:

The Engineer's (Paragon Engineering) pre-tender estimate was \$2.44 million including GST.

EVALUATION

The City received five tender submissions, and upon review for accuracy and completeness, one of the tenders was found to be non-compliant. Of the compliant tenders, there were two arithmetic errors that had no bearing on the outcome of the tender process. All compliant submissions included the required 10% bid bond, were signed on the Tender Form, and were initialled on the Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, Pedre Contractors Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 90 working days as stipulated in the contract. Pedre Contractors Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Pedre Contractors Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 4713-003-11.

SUSTAINABILITY CHARTER/CONSIDERATIONS

The City is responsible for effective and sustainable design, construction and maintenance of infrastructure assets to provide safe and reliable services to our residents and businesses, while also ensuring the infrastructure meets the demands of future growth and economic development. - All Infrastructure Do2: Infrastructure systems provide safe, reliable and affordable services.

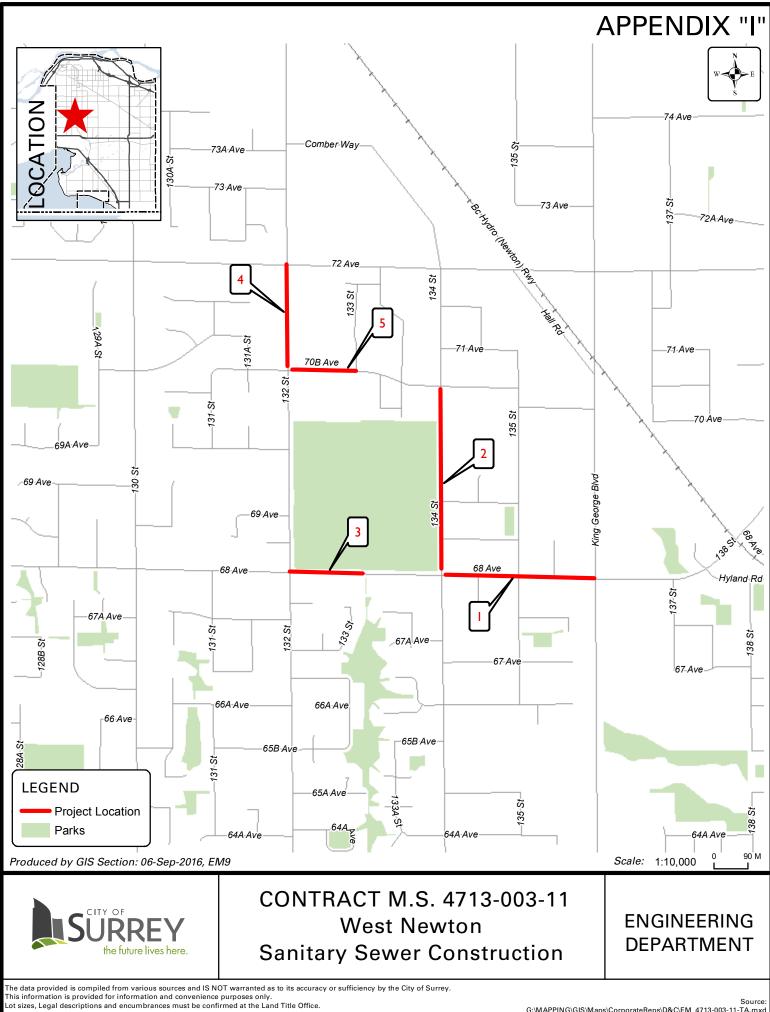
FUNDING
