**Bridgeview Drive Widening – Phase 2 Road Works**

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

1. Award Contract M.S. 1715-009-21 to B&B Contracting (2012) Ltd. in the amount of \$6,024,600.00, including GST, for the Bridgeview Drive Widening – Phase 2 Road Works;
2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract M.S. 1715-009-21 at \$6,630,000.00 including GST and contingency; and
3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract M.S. 1715-009-21.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

The construction package related to this contract is the second and final phase of the road widening of Bridgeview Drive between 111 Avenue and Highway 17, and consists primarily of excavation and placement of aggregate fill, asphalt milling and paving, concrete works, signal rebuilds, and streetlights. The project extents are illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix “I”.

The contract work is expected to commence mid-March 2017 and be completed not later than October 31, 2017.

**TENDER RESULTS**

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on February 9, 2017 with the following results:

The Engineer's (WEB Engineering Ltd.) pre-tender estimate was \$5,930,000 including GST.

## EVALUATION

The City's consultant reviewed the tender submissions for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond, were signed on the Tender Form, and were initialed on the Summary Sheet of the Schedule of Quantities and Prices.

The low bidder, B&B Contracting (2012) Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work by October 31, 2017, as stipulated in the contract. B&B Contracting (2012) Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that B&B Contracting (2012) Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1715-009-21.

## SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

This contract supports the objectives of the Sustainability Charter. In particular, this work relates to the Sustainability Charter theme of Public Safety with the overall goal of having a safe city to live, work, learn and play in. Specifically, this contract supports the following Desired Outcomes:

- Transportation Safety Dog: Transportation network supports and provides safe mobility for all ages and abilities; and
- Transportation Safety Do10: Surrey is part of a coordinated effort to reduce the risk of harm for all road users, with attention to those who are most vulnerable, including pedestrians and cyclists.

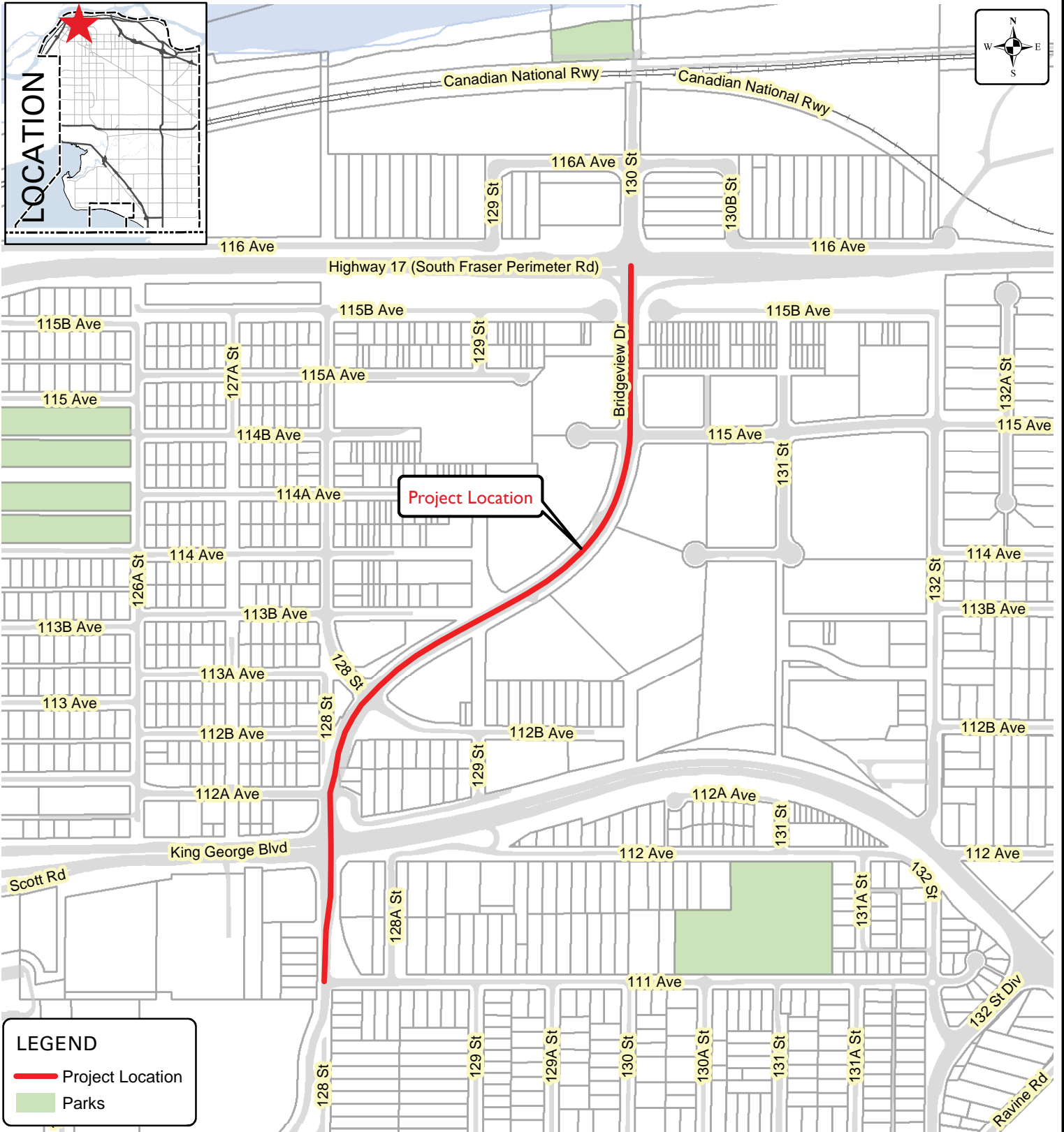
## FUNDING

Funding for this contract is available in the approved 2017 Transportation Budget. In 2016, the City was successful in receiving \$3.04 million in funding from Transport Canada as part of the Asia Pacific Gateway Corridor Initiative for this project. This amounts to approximately 47% of the total projected project costs.
