# RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- Award Contract 1220-040-2017-075 to Grandview Blacktop Ltd. in the amount of \$681,018.66, including GST, for arterial milling and paving services at various locations throughout the City; and
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract 1220-040-2017-075 at \$757,069.59, including GST and contingency; and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract 1220-040-2017-075.

# **SCOPE OF WORK**

The construction package related to this contract consists of permanent road cut milling and hot-mix pavement patching on major roads at the locations illustrated in Appendix "I".

The contract work is expected to start in July 2017 and be completed by October 31, 2017.

#### **QUOTATION RESULTS**

In accordance with the Purchase and Expenditure Authorization Bylaw, the RFQ was posted on BC Bid and the City of Surrey website. The following contractors submitted quotes:

The Engineer's (R.F. Binnie & Associates Ltd.) pre-tender estimate to complete the works contained within the construction package was \$825,961.50, including GST.

#### **EVALUATION**

The tender submissions were reviewed for accuracy and completeness, and no errors were found.

The low bidder, Grandview Blacktop Ltd., submitted a quote below the pre-tender estimate and is included in the Engineering Department's approved paving contractor list. In addition, Grandview Blacktop Ltd. has no outstanding legal claims against the City. It is recommended that Grandview Blacktop Ltd. be awarded Contract M.S. 1220-040-2017-075.

#### SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

This project supports the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter. In particular, the work of this project relates to the Sustainability Charter theme of Infrastructure. Specifically, this project supports the following Desired Outcomes:

## FUNDING


Funding for this Contract is available in the approved 2017 Streets Maintenance budget and the Pavement Cut Deposit account.
