SUBJECT: Sponsorship Request - Canada India Networking Initiative (CINI) 2018

RECOMMENDATION

The Finance Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Receive this report for information; and
- 2. Approve a sponsorship contribution of \$2,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund in support of the Canada India Networking Initiative (CINI) 2018 Opening Reception and Banquet taking place at Surrey City Hall and Royal King Palace and Convention Centre on June 8th and June 9th, 2018.

BACKGROUND

The City has received a sponsorship request from Canada India Networking Society, in support of the CINI 2018. The event will be held at various locations in Surrey from June 8- 11, 2018. This report addresses that request.

DISCUSSION

The Canada India Network Society in partnership with Simon Fraser University, Fraser Health Authority, Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin, and Canadian Association of Physicians of Indian Origin is hosting CINI 2018 in Surrey from June 8-11, 2018. The purpose of this initiative is to promote a healthy civil society through innovation, technology and engagement in health care. This multi-day event will bring together leaders from Canada and India to discuss health issues such as Diabetes, Mental Health and Addiction, and Palliative Care. The Canada India Networking Society is seeking sponsorship for CINI 2018 taking place at various locations in Surrey. A copy of the information provided by Canada India Networking Society related to CINI 2018 is attached to this report as Appendix "1".

This sponsorship request does not satisfy the evaluation criteria for a City grant as stipulated in the City Grant Policy since the event includes a fundraising component; however, Council has previously provided funding to similar events through the Council Initiatives Fund.

Staff has reviewed this request and recommend that Council support this event through a sponsorship in the amount of \$2,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund. This sponsorship will offset facility rental costs associated with the Opening Reception to be held on June 8th, 2018 at Surrey City Hall. Additionally, the City will receive a table for 8 attendees at the Banquet taking place on Saturday, June 9th, 2018 at the Royal King Palace and Convention Centre in Surrey.

SUSTAINABILITY

CINI 2018 supports the overall objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter as related to the themes of Inclusion, Public Safety and Health and Wellness. Specifically, this grant will support the following desired outcomes (DO):

- Inclusion DO2: Surrey is a caring and compassionate city that learns about and supports its residents of all backgrounds, demographics and life experiences.

- Health & Wellness DO: Surrey has a full range of high quality, community-based health services and programs that address health and wellness.
- Health & Wellness DO₅: Services and programs are responsive to shifting health and social needs, and local and external factors.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council approve a sponsorship contribution of \$2,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to Canada India Network Society in support of the CINI 2018 Opening Reception and Banquet taking place at Surrey City Hall and Royal King Palace and Convention Centre on June 8th and June 9th, 2018.
