SUBJECT: Sponsorship Request - Surrey Women's Centre

RECOMMENDATION

The Finance Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Receive this report for information; and
- 2. Approve a sponsorship request of \$1,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to the Surrey Women's Centre in support of their 25th anniversary event being held on June 9th, 2018 at Holland Park.

INTENT

The purpose of this report is to request that Mayor and Council support a sponsorship request from the Council Initiatives Fund towards the Surrey Women's Centre 25th anniversary event.

DISCUSSION

The Surrey Women's Centre is a crisis centre for women and girls escaping domestic violence, sexual assault and other forms of gender-based violence. The organization operates the Surrey Mobile Assault Response Team which is a crisis response group that provides services over the phone and in-person to anyone who has experienced a physical or sexual assault by a stranger or someone they know. The team is available 24-hours a day, year-round, to assist with access to emergency medical, legal and social services. Other services offered include a drop-in centre, workshops and clinics, counselling, support groups, and legal advocacy.

To commemorate their 25th anniversary, the Surrey Women's Centre will be hosting the Justice, Power and Freedom Celebration on June 9th, 2018 at Holland Park as shown in Appendix "I" attached to this report. The organization's goal is to raise \$25,000 through this event with all contributions supporting the operational requirements of their Surrey Mobile Assault Response Team (SMART) van. The SMART van is a mobile crisis centre and emergency van service for sex workers who can't always call when they need help. The objective is to reach women at street level where they work, reducing barriers to vital aid, resources and options.

Staff have evaluated the request and recommend that Council approve a sponsorship of \$1,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund in support of the Surrey Women's Centre 25th anniversary event. This level of sponsorship will designate the City as a "freedom donor." The City of Surrey will be recognized through the inclusion of the City's logo in the anniversary booklet.

FUNDING

Appendix "II" attached to this report documents the balance in the Council Initiatives Fund based on an assumption that Council will approve the recommendations of this report.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The Surrey Women's Centre 25th anniversary event supports the overall objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter 2.0 as related to the themes of Public Safety and Health and Wellness. Specifically, this sponsorship will support the following Desired Outcomes (DO):

- Public Safety DO1: Residents are safe and have a strong sense of security in all neighbourhoods and throughout the city; and
- Health and Wellness DO1: Surrey has a full range of high quality, community-based health and social services and programs that address health and wellness.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above discussion, it is recommended that Council approve a sponsorship of \$1,000 from the Council Initiatives Fund to the Surrey Women's Centre in support of their 25th anniversary event.
