SUBJECT: Supplemental Funding Requests - 2018 Cultural Grants Program

RECOMMENDATION

The Parks, Recreation & Culture Department and the Finance Department recommend that Council:

- 1. Receive this report for information; and
- 2. Approve under the Cultural Grants Program two (2) supplemental grants totalling \$4,300, as generally described in this report.

INTENT

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval for the issuance of two (2) supplemental grants under the Cultural Grants Program (the "Program") for 2018.

BACKGROUND

At its Regular meeting on January 22, 2018 Council adopted the recommendations of Corporate Report No. R013; 2018 titled "Cultural Grants Program - 2018 Grant Allocations" and provided approval of cultural grants to eighty-three (83) organizations totalling \$397,453.

At its Regular meeting on April 9, 2018 Council adopted the recommendations of Corporate Report No. Ro62; 2018 titled "Supplemental Funding Requests – 2018 Cultural Grants Program" and provided approval of cultural grants to four (4) organizations totalling \$23,600.

At its Regular meeting on June 11, 2018 Council adopted the recommendations of Corporate Report No. R133; 2018 titled "Supplemental Funding Requests – 2018 Cultural Grants Program" and provided approval of cultural grants to seven (7) organizations totalling \$24,025.

As per the Program Guidelines, the balance of available funds for 2018 has been reserved for additional emerging projects throughout 2018. At this time, the Evaluation Committee is bringing forward this report to recommend funding two (2) supplemental projects. Appendix "I" provides information on the status of funding related to the Cultural Grants Program based on the assumption that Council will approve the recommendations in this report.

DISCUSSION

Following is a summary of the two (2) supplemental grant applications received:

AgentC Projects

AgentC Projects is a local artist collective that focuses on the role of curator as agent in the ongoing development of contemporary art. Project grant funding will be used to produce an exhibition and opening event at the Crescent Beach Pop-Up Gallery. The Evaluation Committee recommends awarding \$3,500 to support this initiative.

Phoenix Society

The Phoenix Society is partnering with City Opera Vancouver to present a free professional opera performance for members of the Surrey recovery community. This event will be held at Centre Stage at City Hall. The Evaluation Committee recommends awarding \$800 to support this initiative.

Evaluation of Application

The applications were reviewed by the Evaluation Committee, which is comprised of staff and one representative of the Culture Development Advisory Committee, using a point rating system against the following Program criteria:

- Merit of the initiative for which grant funding is requested;
- Potential community impact of the initiative; and
- Health and capacity of the applicant organization to carry out the initiative.

Based on their evaluation, the Evaluation Committee recommends that Council approve under the Cultural Grants Program two (2) supplemental grants totalling \$4,300.

Status of Program Funding

Following is a summary of the 2018 Cultural Grant Program funding allocation to date:

2018 Cultural Grants Budget	\$500,000
Grant funding allocated to date	\$445,078
Unallocated balance	\$54,922

Assuming Council support of these two (2) supplemental funding requests totalling \$4,300, the remaining funds in the 2018 Cultural Grants budget for emerging opportunities will be \$50,622.

Distributing the Cultural Grants

In accordance with the Program Guidelines and subject to approval of the grants by Council the applicants will receive eighty percent (80%) of the approved grant funding up front with the remaining balance to be forwarded to the applicant upon the receipt and acceptance by the City of a final report submitted by the applicant that demonstrates that the work or activity for which the grant was awarded has been duly completed.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The Cultural Grants Program supports the Community Theme of "Education and Culture" identified in the City's Sustainability Charter 2.0. Specifically the Cultural Grants Program supports the following Desired Outcome (DO):

• Arts and Heritage - DO7: An enviable and vibrant arts and heritage sector contributes to Surrey's citizen engagement, enrichment, economy, community liveability and civic pride.

CONCLUSION

The Parks, Recreation & Culture Department and the Finance Department recommend that Council approve under the 2018 Cultural Grants Program the two (2) supplemental grants as generally described in this report.
