TIMELINE*

- **January 16, 2025:** Submission deadline
- **January 20, 2025:** Selected artists will be notified
- **Friday, January 24, 2025, 9am-4pm at Historic Stewart Farm:** Artwork delivery date. Artworks will not be accepted outside of these times*
- **January 28, 2024 – March 6 2025:** Exhibition dates
- **Friday, March 7, 2025, 9am-4pm at Historic Stewart Farm:** Artwork pickup date. Artworks will not be available for pickup outside of these times*

- Are 2D and ready to hang. Unframed artworks will not be accepted.
- Reflect the theme "Local Flora and Fauna"
- Appropriate for all ages and cultures.

APPLICATION CONTENTS

Please include:

- Name
- Artwork Title
- Phone
- Email
- Address
- Brief statement about your artwork (no more than 30 words), including themes, inspirations, or concepts you want the viewer to know about.
- Photos of each artwork in a high resolution.
- Details for each artwork: name, dimensions, medium (what kind of material did you use?)
- Please prioritize your submitted artworks in order of preference for display. Note that we cannot guarantee that all pieces will be displayed.
- Permission to use submitted photos in promotional materials.

- Drop off and pick up my artwork at the pre-determined times listed.
