## Literacy Month

## September 2024

WHEREAS	literacy is more than reading, writing, and numeracy, but encompasses identifying,
	understanding, interpreting, creating, and communicating, to achieve one's goals and to
	develop one's knowledge and potential; and

WHEREAS	in British Columbia more than 700,000 working-age adults struggle with literacy and
	numeracy which hampers their ability to participate fully in society; and

WHEREAS	engaging children and youth in literacy activities ensures the best opportunity for
	literacy development and lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS	many organizations in Surrey, British Columbia, including READ Surrey/White Rock Society, Surrey Libraries, and the Surrey White Rock Literacy Task Group, work to raise awareness of literacy issues, help people of all ages develop the literacy skills necessary
	to improve their life opportunities, and create a community that values and supports literacy and learning.
