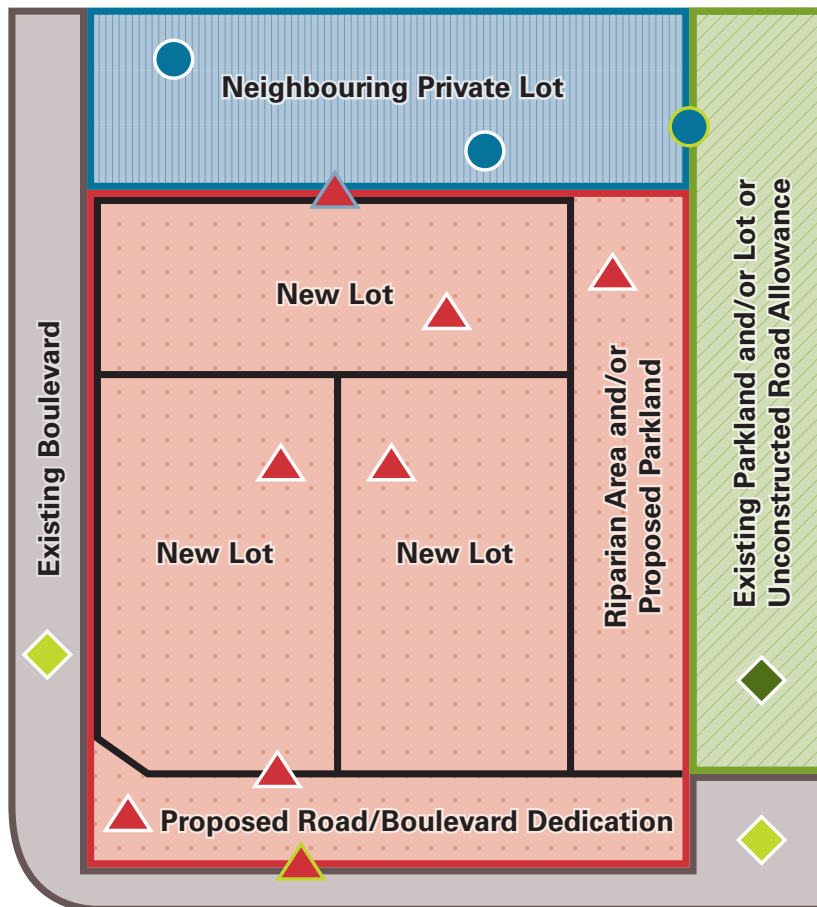





Tree Location Guide



On-site Trees



 **INITIAL DEVELOPMENT LOT**

-  **On-site**
-  **Shared with Off-site**
(Removal requires written agreement from neighbour)
-  **Shared with Park/City or Boulevard**
(Parks to review and approve removal/retention)

Trees on proposed boulevard and proposed parkland are to be reviewed by Parks. Removal and replacement to be captured in on-site totals.

Off-site Trees



 **NEIGHBOURING PRIVATE LOT**

-  **Off-site**
-  **Shared - Off-site and City**
(Parks to review and approve removal/retention)

A separate Tree Cutting Permit application signed by the neighbouring property owner is required. The permit will be issued with separate fees and replacement requirements.

City Trees

 **EXISTING PARKLAND**  **EXISTING BOULEVARD**

-  **Park/City**
-  **Boulevard**

All city trees, regardless of size, within 10m of the development site are to be captured in the arborist report.

Trees on proposed boulevard and proposed parkland are to be reviewed by Parks. Removal and replacement to be captured in on-site totals.

Parks determines compensation for city tree removals.
