INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

This Addendum is issued to provide additional information to the RFQ for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor not being familiar with this Addendum. This Addendum No. 3 contains two (2) pages in total.

- Q1: Can you please elaborate further on the types of tires we are dealing with? Are these pick-up tires, truck tires, fork-lift tires?
- A1: Tires will generally be from illegal dumping and would include small vehicle, pickup tires and heavy duty vehicle tires.
- Q2: What type of Styrofoam are we talking about? How clean is it?
- A2: Styrofoam will be packaging from new equipment or other types of inventory and will generally be clean material.
- Q3: Additional Services Section Part A: Does the city own those compactors now? Or does the City want the Contractor to provide the compactors? Secondly, can you tell us what those compactors are for? Third, how often do you want them to be picked up?
- A3: The City does not own the compactors and the Contractor will be responsible to provide the compactors. The compactors would be for recycling material (paper, cardboard) and garbage or any other Collection Material that a compactor can accommodate. The City does not have a set service frequency for the compactors and will only be used as required by the City.

- Q4: Additional Services Section Part B: Can you provide the frequency of the services for those front-end dumpsters? How often do you wish them to be picked / serviced?
- A4: The City does not have a set service frequency for the compactors and will only be used as required by the City.
- Q5: Can you please explain the City of Surrey's intent with regards to the compactors rentals? Typically, these pieces of equipment are around \$35,000 to purchase and then there are installation costs on top of that. Compactors are usually a permanent solution to waste and recycling needs. Even the free-standing units that do not connect to the interior of the building require electrical hookup, a cement pad with guiderails and other installation procedures. Normally, we would request a 3 to 5 year agreement when it comes to compactor equipment and are confused by the per day, per week and per month pricing requirement. Are you able to confirm in what capacity these compactors would be required as we want to be able to fully understand how to price this competitively.
- A5: For clarification, the costs for the compactors are listed as "Additional Services". The City may elect to use the Compactors at its sole discretion in place of the Container Requirements listed in Schedule A-1 or at any other location as may be required by the City. The Contractor may submit alternative financial Quotations for additional services; however, the information requested should be supplied and will be used for Quotation evaluation purposes.
