INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS

This Addendum is issued to provide additional information to the RFQ for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor not being familiar with this Addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains one (1) page in total.

- Q1: Is there a possibility that the city will choose to only perform the works at a portion of the locations, or is it guaranteed that all the locations will proceed when awarded?
- A1: All locations should proceed when awarded. We intend to complete 10 locations with these works.
- Q2: Can we leave sidewalk panels flush with gravel and then once all locations are done in regards to civil works come back and provide the concrete/asphalt restoration?
- A2: There should be a smooth surface to ensure it is accessible for wheelchairs and strollers. So temporary asphalt would be required if the time period for restoration is expected to be longer than a week.
- Q3: What type of push button is a 'special pushbutton'? Is a bulldog adequate?
- A3: Bulldog push button is adequate. Special crosswalk plate is required above the push button to specify it is for a warning device and not the same plate as a traffic signal. These plates will be supplied by the City.
