The City would prefer to receive quotations on or before March 8th, 2022.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Q1. Are there any chambers to inspect?

A1. There are no service connection chambers to inspect. There are chamber MH's to inspect that are not circular.

Q2. Are there any storm culverts were inspection or only storm pipes that go from MH-MH.

A2. There are culverts to inspect. The vast majority of the contract are mains, MH to MH.

Q3. How is the contractor paid for each line assuming it is 60 meters long and you do 1 inspection from each way. Would the contractor get paid for 120 meters or 60 meters total?

A3. 60m total.

Q4. What happens if the line has blockages such as roots, debris etc. and the entire view of the pipe is not visible would the contractor still get back for the entire length of the line?

A4. Yes.
