## **INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTORS**

Contractors are advised that Addendum No. 1 to 1220-040-2020-027 is hereby issued by the City. This addendum shall form part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors, for the above-named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractors or any sub-contractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains five (5) pages.

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

- Q1. Are we removing the garbage bins?
- A1. No, the Contractor is responsible for picking up litter and debris as defined in the RFQ from all lawn and hard surfaces within the designated area only and disposing of it off site in an appropriate manner.
- Q2. Are we responsible for garbage bags?
- A2. Yes, the Contractor must provide the bags for whatever litter and debris that will be collected.
- Q3. All the little & debris going to garbage bin under this contract or we have to take the garbage to the dump site?
- A3. The Contractor is responsible for disposing of any collected litter and debris off site in an appropriate manner at the appropriate facility. The Contractor is not permitted to put any collected litter and debris into any existing garbage bin within the park sites. Existing garbage bins are emptied by a separate Contractor.

- Q4. Is there any kilometers for all the parks sites?
- A4. Please see Clarifications and the updated Fees and Payments table attached to this Addendum No.1. The City encourages the Contractor to use the maps provided in the RFQ.
- Q5. Are we responsible for any park event or fair to pick up extra debris & litter?
- A5. Any large-scale event or fair hosts that receive a permit to operate will be required to provide their own garbage plan. However, the Contractor will be responsible for any litter and debris that remains following gatherings such as company picnics or family barbecues. Any large or excessive litter or debris as defined in the RFQ may be reported for City staff to collect.
- Q6. If there is heavy glass, metal or container what we have to do with that.
- A6. Any large or excessive litter or debris as defined in the RFQ may be reported for City staff to collect, otherwise the Contractor is responsible to collect and dispose of all litter which includes, but is not limited to, signs, waste, broken glass, shopping carts, bottles, needles, cans, papers, and other unsightly debris within the designated areas.
