INFORMATION FOR TENDERERS

Tenderers are advised that Addendum No. 2 to 1220-020-2023-005 is hereby issued by the City. This addendum shall form part of the contract documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts.

- **Q.1** For tendering purposes, can we assume that there is no asbestos in the existing concrete poles to be removed?
- A.1 Given the age of the associated infrastructure, assume that there may be hazard materials in any of the elements. All necessary measures need to be taken when demolishing, disposing, and/or modifying old infrastructure.
- **Q.2** Please confirm that any testing for asbestos including any abatement would be additional to the contract if required.
- A.2 As necessary, testing will be the responsibility of the Contractor and in scope of the contract.

- **Q.3** What are the requirements for driving in the existing tennis court surface?
- A.3 Access to tennis court surface to complete work will be limited to a specific location as identified in the attached site image. Driving on the courts should be minimized and limited to necessary areas only. An anticipated court travel path is identified in the attached site image. 3/4" plywood must be laid on the surfacing in all areas of travel on the courts, to protect surface from wear and damage.
- **Q.4** Is the City aware that it won't be possible to match the color of the existing faded court surface for the pavement trench restoration?
- A.4 The City is aware that reinstated surfacing may not match existing colours.
- **Q.5** Will the arborist be provided by the City of Surrey at no cost to the contractor?
- A.5 Tree protection barrier to City standard will be required around 12 trees adjacent to pole locations, as indicated in the attached site image. Supervising arborist services are not generally required for areas outside of the tree protection barriers. One exception is the pole T4 location. Contractor shall auger pole T4 under the City's arborist supervision. City will provide arborist supervision at no expense to the Contractor. Contractor is responsible for coordinating arborist supervision and must provide minimum 48 hours advance notice.

Additional Information

- City will remove benches around centre pole in advance and at no cost to the Contractor.
- City will remove all fencing scrim in advance at no cost to the Contractor.

Please ensure that this Addendum No. 2 is noted in the Form of Tender.

All Addenda will become part of the Contract Documents.
